The Resolution reads as follows.

Resolution 2008-3

To Defend Consultants and Sub-consultants from Claim of Trespass

The City of Greensburg, Indiana Board of Aviation Commissioners do hereby resolve to defend the firm known as Butler, Fairman, and Seufert, and their sub-consultants, including Ball State University, and any individuals employed by these entities, from any claim or financial responsibility resulting from legal claims for trespass during the performance of their normal duties while working on the Environmental Assessment for the Board of Aviation Commissioners.
