

**City of Greensburg Board of Aviation Commissioners
April 26, 2010**

The meeting of the Greensburg Board of Aviation Commissioners convened on Monday, April 26th, at 7:00 p.m. All members were present. President Bill Ernstes called the meeting to order. Roll was called.

The agenda was presented. In old business, Gerald Hall memorial was added. Skydive Greensburg and Martin Brunner were removed. In new business, Don Manley was added.

Motion 238-10 Jon moved to accept the agenda with the noted changes. Ed seconded and the motion was carried.

The March minutes were read. **Motion 239-10 Jim moved to accept the March minutes. Don seconded and roll call was unanimous.**

Old Business: Jon updated the Board on the progress with the Gerald Hall memorial plaque. Jon has spoken with two different companies to get quotes for adding Gerald's likeness to the plaques. As to date, he has not received the quotes.

New Business: The packet of bills was presented. **Motion 240-10 Ed moved to pay the bills as listed. With Jim's second roll call was unanimous.**

Don Manley requested the Board to approve and sign the grant application for \$157,895.00. This application is to cover the environmental assessment report. The report has gone through the first round of comments with the FAA. The report will go through more comment rounds then it will be advertised for a public hearing. **Motion 241-10 Jim moved to authorize Bill to sign the application as presented by Butler, Fairman & Seufert representative Don Manley. With Jon's second roll call was unanimous.**

Don concluded with quotes from written articles that boast aviation as a positive impact on the economy. He also noted that the month of April is General Aviation Appreciation month.

The Board asked for comments from the public. A public citizen spoke his opinion on the airport expansion. He views the expansion much like the construction and usage of Interstate 74. He noted that the airport will be a benefit to the city and believes it will be able to support itself. He concluded that he would like to see the project move forward.
