

**City of Greensburg Board of Aviation Commissioners

Old Business: The vasi lights are aligned. However the lights need to be narrowed due to too much emitting from the sides.

Bob stated that Skydive Greensburg has no intentions of leaving Greensburg when the expansion is complete.
