### Roll Call

Present: Jon Dooley, Bill Ernestes, Jim Pruett, and Don Whipple. Absent: Ed Dwenger

**Motion made by Jon Dooley and seconded by Don Whipple to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried.**

The minutes from October's meeting were presented for approval. **Motion by Jon Dooley and seconded by Jim Pruett to approve as amended. Motion carried.**

### Old Business

Jon Dooley gave the financial report on the Airport Balances.

Don Whipple reported on the status of the SRE building. He has visited Miller's and measured the equipment. He estimated that a pole style barn would cost between \$15,000-\$25,000. A steel building would cost around \$45,000 - \$50,000. Don Manley stated that an environmental assessment and airspace study could take up to 90 days to complete depending upon ground conditions. **Motion by Jim Pruett and seconded by Don Whipple to allow BF&S, under the general service contract, be authorized to begin an Archeological and Airspace study hourly not to exceed \$4,000 without further approval from the BOAC. Motion carried.**

### New Business

Each board member received a copy of the airport rules to review. The board discussed commercial leases verses personal leases. **Motion by Jon Dooley and seconded by Jim Pruett to table discussion of the airport rules and leases until receiving Don Tribbett's recommendation. Motion carried.**

The bill packet was presented for approval. The Best Way bill was removed. **Motion to approve remaining bills as presented by Jon Dooley and seconded by Jim Pruett. Motion carried.**

Dennis Dickman came forward from the audience with an issue of Skydive Greensburg going onto his fields without permission. Jon Dooley reported that while the BOAC understands his frustrations, the FAA has informed them that they cannot come between the property owner and Skydive. Don Whipple reinforced that they cannot enforce rules on other people's property and the BOAC has been informed that they are not to mediate by the Mayor and the BOAC attorney.

Don Manley discussed the CIP. He would like for the BOAC to have discussion in November and then motions be made in December.

**Motion to adjourn by Jim Pruett and seconded by Don Whipple. Motion carried.**
