Present: Mayor Gary Herbert, Herb Hunter and Steve Simmonds. Linda Oldham and Dr. Rodney King were absent.

RE: Barachel Lane Partial Closure

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Steve Cobb requested the partial closure of Barachel Lane be rescheduled from the original dates of October 5th through November 6th to November 16th through December 18th due to some conflicts on the job site. Herb clarified that this closure was already approved at a previous board meeting and just the dates were being changed. Herb also questioned whether the residents and businesses have been notified of the closure. Steve Cobb stated that letters had been sent out and the newspaper had been notified.

Motion by Steve Simmonds and seconded by Herb Hunter to approve the partial closing of Barachel Lane from November 16th through December 18th 2009. All ayes. So passed.

Mayor Herbert asked City Engineer Gary Murray to give an update on the Vandalia Road Project. Gary stated that the right of way services contract for the project had been drafted and was already approved at the last meeting. All but two property owners have been contacted and are allowing us to come on the property. Those last two property owners will be contacted.

Gary Murray and Street Commissioner Mark Klosterkemper gave an update on Lincoln Street. The demolition is starting on Giddings Cleaners. The dumpster should be onsite by Wednesday. The crew will be working on marking the temporary lanes within the next few days.
