

## BOARD OF WORKS

April 1, 2013

Time: 5:00 P.M.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call was taken

PRESENT: Mayor Gary Herbert, Darrell Poling, Linda Oldham, Steve Simmonds and Rodney King.

Mayor Herbert requested that the board to amend the agenda adding Reedy Financial Group for discussion purposes. Rodney King moved to add Reedy Financial Group to the agenda and Linda Oldham seconded, all ayes and no nays, motion passed.

Minutes from March 4, 2013 were presented for approval. Darrell Poling moved to accept the minutes as presented and Rodney King seconded, all ayes and no nays, motion passed.

**Scott Chasteen – Fire Chief** provided an update on the new firefighter Chris Baker and that his start date on the department would be April 15<sup>th</sup>. 8 people put in for the captains position after promoting Brian Wenning to assistant fire chief. Honda Contract has been extended 30 days so that Honda can get the contract back on a fiscal year basis. 24 applications were received for a probationary firefighter position and agility testing is being scheduled for those applicants.

**Stacey Chasteen** provided an update on the K-9 Program. Letters have been sent out and have raised over half of the money for training expenses. Krieger is on the road and has been for about two weeks. A K-9 incident report is being used to track Krieger's deployment. A probationary officer has been hired and will start as soon as he can.

Mayor Herbert discussed the Reedy Financial Group and the possibility of them coming to the May Meeting to discuss plans for a capital improvement plan to be adopted by the City of Greensburg. Clerk Bridgett Weber also discussed them coming to the May Meeting to introduce themselves and discuss a contract with the City of Greensburg. Steve Simmonds moved to allow Reedy Financial Group

to attend the May Board Meeting to discuss a contract and Linda Oldham seconded, all ayes no nays, motion passed.

**Mark Klosterkemper – Street Commissioner** presented proposals for uniform service for the Street Department. Proposals were received from Cintas, G & K Services and Plymate. Cintas is the current provider. Mark Klosterkemper’s recommendation is a 3 year agreement with G & K Services. Darrell Poling moved to sign a 3 year agreement with G & K Services and Steve Simmonds seconded, all ayes and no nays, motion passed.

Mark Klosterkemper also requested to replace the Brush Truck that is approximately 26 years old and is out of service. The worth of this truck with repairs will be \$1500.00. A used truck is being looked at in the range of \$30,000.00 where a new purchase would be \$100,000.00. Mark Klosterkemper would like the board to allow the Mayor, Mechanic and Street Commissioner to purchase this truck. Rodney King moved to allow Mayor, Mechanic and Street Commissioner to purchase vehicle with an installment plan not to exceed 3 years and Darrell Poling seconded, all ayes and no nays, motion passed.

**Robin Meyer – Water Board Member** introduced Pete Brown of Mueller Systems. Mueller Systems will be doing all the training to help City of Greensburg install the new meters. Installation will start in June and hope to be completed in October 2013. The host subscription will cost \$13,500 per year. Rodney King moved to accept the contract with Mueller Systems and Steve Simmonds seconded, all ayes and no nays, motion passed.

Redevelopment Commission has asked Chris Stephen to review the check list to amend the capital improvement plan.

Pirates Basketball Team will be having a parade and rally on Wednesday April 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Linda Oldham moved to adjourn at 6:10 pm.
