Roll call was taken.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited

PRESENT: Mayor Gary Herbert, Rodney King, Darrell Poling and Steve Simmonds ABSENT: Linda Oldham

Minutes from June 3 and Special Meeting of June 17th were presented for approval. Rodney King moved to accept the minutes as presented and Darrell Poling seconded all ayes and no nays, motion passed.

Darrell Poling moved to amend the agenda to permit discussion for an income survey to be performed for the possibility of future grants and Rodney King seconded all ayes no nays, motion passed.

Darren Covington – Carousel Play and Learn Center 5K submitted a map of the proposed for the 5K course. Rodney King moved to approve the 5K event working with street, police and fire and Steve Simmonds seconded all ayes and no nays, motion passed.

Darrell Poling moved to table Emily Edwards’ request at this time and Rodney King seconded all ayes and no nays, motion passed.

Robert Duckworth and Joyce Holtkamp – Fair Parade Route requested areas that have been closed or temporarily closed in years past during the fair parade on July 14th. Steve Simmonds moved to approve fair parade route and Rodney King seconded all ayes no nays, motion passed.

Gary Murray – City Engineer presented a contract to tear down an unsafe building at 606 N East Street. Ron Adkins would like to purchase the property from the tax sale lien buyer and tear down the unsafe building himself. Rodney King moved to table contract until next meeting in August and Steve Simmonds seconded all ayes no nays, motion passed.

Gary Murray presented information to update the **City’s Comprehensive Plan** from 2006. An income survey in the amount of \$3,150.00 would need to be performed to see if we qualify to apply for the grant for \$40,000.00. Mayor Herbert would use EDIT Funds to complete the survey. Darrell Poling moved to allow the income survey to be performed at the cost of \$3,150.00 with EDIT Funds and Steve Simmonds seconded all ayes and no nays, motion passed.

Darrell Poling moved to allow Emily Edwards to speak. Emily requested to have a 5K Run on September 14th. Proceeds would benefit Journey Home Jamaica. Emily Edwards requested to use the same course that Delta Theta Tau Sorority and other non-profit organizations have used for 5K run fund raising. Rodney King moved to table until she can obtain non-profit status for the organization and Steve Simmonds seconded all ayes and no nays, motion passed.
