Roll call was taken

PRESENT: Mayor Gary Herbert, Darrell Poling, Steve Simmonds and Linda Oldham.

Linda Oldham moved to approve minutes for the regular meeting of August 4th, 2014 and Steve Simmonds seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Joan Eversole – First Baptist Church of Greensburg requested street closure on Monfort and Jackson streets for their church on the lawn event on September 14, 2014. Darrell Poling moved to allow street closures as requested and Steve Simmonds seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Dave Stults – Tree County Players use of City Hall Gym on **October 24th and 25th** with a set up date of October 18th Linda Oldham moved to allow use of the gym and Steve Simmonds seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Wendy Blake – Mainstreet Greensburg requested use of City Hall Gym on the second Saturday during the months of November – April for the Winter Farmer's Market. Darrell Poling moved to allow the use of the gym and Linda Oldham seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Scott Chasteen – Fire Chief requested the Board of Works to discuss the possibility of revising or rescinding the City's Peddler Permit Ordinance. The Mayor and Department Heads have expressed a safety concern when it comes to door to door solicitations and street collections. Scott Chasteen acted as a spokesperson at the meeting to get the conversation started and asking for Board of Works feedback.

Mayor Herbert presented a draft of **Ordinance 2014-16 Limited Duty Policy** as an addendum to Ordinance 2011-4 City of Greensburg's Personnel Policy Handbook. The current worker's compensation policy is being held by a high risk pool provider based on our claims in the past three years. This policy can start to reduce costs and future premiums if implemented. Steve Simmonds moved to approve the draft of Ordinance 2014-16 and to request Council approval and Linda Oldham seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.
