Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call was taken

PRESENT: Mayor Gary Herbert, Darrell Poling, Bob King, Linda Oldham and Steve Simmonds.

Linda Oldham moved minutes for the regular meeting of February 2, 2015 as presented and Steve Simmonds seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Mark Klosterkemper – Street Commissioner and Chris Stephen City Attorney opened bids for **Bridge #188**. Bids were received from **Hoosier Pride Excavating \$449,216.40, Dave O’Mara Contracting \$630,737.47 and Paul H Rohe & Company \$418,929.00**. All bids were taken under advisement and subject to all specifications being met.
