

# COMMON COUNCIL MEETING

November 3, 2003

TIME: 6:00 P.M.

**Present:** Mayor Gary Bailey , Ed Dwenger, Herb Hunter, Helen Gardner , David Leas and Bruce Tressler.

Minutes were approved.

Kathy Crippen explained the American Legal Publishing Internet Program. The whole Ordinance book would be put on the internet and monies were put in the 2004 budget.

Jan Bartels was present to give the Council an update on New Directions Abuse Shelter. They have two full-time and two part-time employees and are in need of funding to help get them through the end of the year. Five thousand dollars would help to get them through this year until their monies come in from United Fund. Jan also ask the Council if they would consider matching the \$15,000 County is giving next year.

Council stated they have already done budget for next year.

Motion by Ed Dwenger and seconded by Helen Gardner to approve up to \$5,000 if monies are available end of this year. So passed.

**Motion by Helen Gardner and seconded by Ed Dwenger to pass on 2<sup>nd</sup> reading Ordinance 2003-19. So passed.**

**Motion by David Leas and seconded by Ed Dwenger to pass on 3<sup>rd</sup> reading Ordinance 2003-19. So passed.**

**Motion by Herb Hunter and seconded by Helen Gardner to pass Resolution 2003-6. So passed.**

Police Chief, Bill Meyerrose, told Council the Board of Works had approved his request to purchase new handguns in place of repairing all 18 guns.

Bill also told Council about losing their shooting range with the new expansion at the Wastewater Plant and they had been going to Rushville to shoot.

He had talked with Rick Denney and he has an area out by the Flatrock Pumping Station that could be used. Would not cost a lot of money to construct.

Bruce Tressler told Bill that he should approach the County about this and see if they would be willing to help and use.

Mike Wells, Fire Chief, stated they have met with the Department of Commerce and Ball State is doing a survey on income for the area here in Greensburg .

Herb Hunter gave an update on the Board of Works meeting.

Kathy Crippen stated there are lights up in the parking lot at Vandalia Road .
