

COMMON COUNCIL MEETING
MAY 5, 2008
TIME: 7:00 P.M.

Present: Mayor Gary Herbert, Helen Gardner, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Herb Hunter and Bill Wenning.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call was taken with all present and minutes were approved.

The Council discussed Ordinance 2008-02-02 amending salary Ordinance 2007-07-14.

Mayor Herbert requested a \$1200 increase in salary for the position of Assistant Chief.

Helen Gardner asked Police Chief Brian Heaton if he had addressed the comp time of the other two officers in investigations and if Stacey was ok with a \$1200 increase and being Assistant Chief along with being in charge of Investigations. Chief Heaton replied that he is addressing the comp time.

Motion by Jamie and seconded by Bill Wenning to pass on 2nd reading Ordinance 2008-02-02 amending salary Ordinance 2007-07-14. Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Jamie Cain and seconded by Darrell Poling to suspend the rules and regulations for passing Ordinance 2008-02-02 for 3rd reading. Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Jamie Cain and seconded by Bill Wenning to pass on 3rd reading Ordinance 2008-02-02. Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Police Chief Brian Heaton addressed Council stating the school has approached him with requesting to hire an off duty city police officer for patrol at the school for three week-ends starting May 16, 17 and 18th. The officer would need to drive their patrol car and the school would pay for the time and the city would pay for the gas.

Brian said with the current take home vehicle Resolution 2006-9 with no personnel use language in it, the officer would not be allowed to use their patrol

car. He is requesting Council to allow an officer off duty to use their patrol car for three week-ends and the city supply the gasoline.

The Council members gave their approval.

Motion by Helen Gardner and seconded by Herb Hunter to approve a temporary noise variance amendment of the City's Noise Ordinance 130.03 for the State Highway 46 East resurfacing project by Milestone through July 31st. Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Attorney Nick Kile of Barnes & Thornburg Law Firm in Indianapolis explained the annexation laws to Council. He also explained the Resolution 2008-7, fiscal plan and annexation Ordinances 2008-05-05, 2008-05-06 and 2008-05-07, and Ordinance 2008-05-08, providing sewer services.

Motion by Helen Gardner and seconded by Darrell Poling to pass Resolution 2008-7 adopting fiscal plan and definite policy for the annexation of property contiguous to the City of Greensburg, Indiana pursuant to ordinance nos. 2008-05-5, 2008-05-6 and 2008-05-7 (the 421, Musselman and Scheidler annexations.) Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Jamie Cain and seconded by Helen Gardner to pass on 1st reading Ordinance 2008-05-5 an ordinance of the Common Council of the City of Greensburg, Indiana, annexing certain territory to the City of Greensburg, Indiana, placing the same within the corporate boundaries thereof and making the same a part of the City of Greensburg, Indiana (the 421 annexation.) Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Jamie Cain and seconded by Helen Gardner to pass on 1st reading Ordinance 2008-05-6 an ordinance of the Common Council of the City of Greensburg, Indiana, annexing certain territory to the City of Greensburg, Indiana, placing the same within the corporate boundaries thereof and making the same a part of the City of Greensburg, Indiana (the Musselman annexation.) Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Jamie Cain and seconded by Helen Gardner to pass on 1st reading Ordinance 2008-05-7 an Ordinance of the Common Council of the

City of Greensburg, Indiana, annexing certain territory to the City of Greensburg, Indiana, placing the same within the corporate boundaries thereof and making the same a part of the City of Greensburg, Indiana (the Scheidler annexation.) Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Herb Hunter and seconded by Helen Gardner to pass on 1st reading Ordinance 2008-05-8 an Ordinance providing a procedure for applications and agreements for sewer service to unincorporated areas. Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Helen Gardner and seconded by Jamie Cain to pass Resolution 2008-6 Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Greensburg, Indiana accepting and approving the Greensburg Downtown Revitalization Plan and authorizing the submittal to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs. Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Helen Gardner and seconded by Bill Wenning to pass on 1st reading Ordinance 2008-05-9 an Ordinance changing the zoning of real estate from "R-2" one and two family dwellings to "B-2" general business district. Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Bill Wenning and seconded by Helen Gardner to suspend the rules and regulations to pass Ordinance 2008-05-9 for second reading. Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Helen Gardner and seconded by Darrell Poling to pass on 2nd reading Ordinance 2008-05-9. Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Bill Wenning and seconded by Helen Gardner to suspend the rules and regulations to pass Ordinance 2008-05-9 for third reading. Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Helen Gardner and seconded by Bill Wenning to pass on 3rd reading Ordinance 2008-05-9. Ayes Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.
