

COMMON COUNCIL MEETING
NOVEMBER 2, 2009
TIME: 7:00 P.M.

Present: Mayor Gary Herbert, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Helen Gardner, Herb Hunter and Bill Wenning.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call was taken with all present.

Minutes were approved, motion by Herb Hunter and seconded by Helen Gardner. So passed.

Judy Curd of the DGDC presented a plaque to the City of Greensburg 150th Anniversary Steering Committee.

Mayor Herbert commended the DGDC on their donation of \$10,000 to the 150th. Judy Curd gave an update on the DGDC & HOTTCITY combining into MainStreet.

Motion by Herb Hunter and seconded by Darrell Poling to pass on 1st reading Ordinance 2009-15 (amending ordinance no. 1987-8) an Ordinance Designating Stop Signs within Greensburg, Indiana. This ordinance is for one way stops at W. County Road 100N. – Westbound at W. County Road 240 NW and N. County Road 250 W. Ayes Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning, Darrell Poling, Herb Hunter and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion to suspend the rules and regulations by Jamie Cain and seconded by Bill Wenning. Ayes Darrell Poling, Herb Hunter, Bill Wenning, Jamie Cain and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Bill Wenning and seconded by Jamie Cain to pass on 2nd reading Ordinance 2009-15. Ayes Darrell Poling, Herb Hunter, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion to suspend the rules and regulations by Jamie Cain and seconded by Bill Wenning. Ayes Darrell Poling, Herb Hunter, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Jamie Cain and seconded by Darrell Poling to pass on 3rd reading Ordinance 2009-15. Ayes Bill Wenning, Herb Hunter, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Darrell Poling and seconded by Jamie Cain to pass Resolutions 2009-18, 2009-19, 2009-20, 2009-21 and Tax Abatements for Valeo with 5-year on Equipment. Ayes Bill Wenning, Herb Hunter, Jamie Cain, Darrell Poling and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Bill Wenning stated and Helen Gardner agreed that when the committee looked at these tax abatements for Valeo, it is bringing jobs back, Government is backing it and they are putting more money in this plant, here in Greensburg.

City Attorney Tim Coriden explained about the conversation he had with the police chief pertaining to the Peddlers Ordinance. He hopes to have something in another couple of meetings for Council to look at. He wants to make sure a public safety is in this Ordinance, but must be careful not to hurt the businesses and Chamber of Commerce. What they have looked at is in consideration of what has come down from the Supreme Court.

Mayor Herbert introduced the new City Engineer Gary Murray and had him to give a little background of himself.

Vicki Kellerman EDC Director gave an update of the EDC accomplishments. She handed out the EDC Booklet and an agenda to Turin, Italy that she will be visiting to meet with Italian Companies, Fiat and executives.
