

COMMON COUNCIL MEETING
AUGUST 3, 2009
TIME: 7:00 P.M.

Present: Mayor Gary Herbert, Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Helen Gardner and Bill Wenning. Herb Hunter was absent.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call was taken with all present but one, Herb Hunter.

Minutes were approved, motion by Bill Wenning and seconded by Helen Gardner. So passed.

The sign ordinance will be taken back to the Plan Commission for review.

Motion by Helen Gardner and seconded by Bill Wenning to pass on 1st reading Ordinance 2009-9 and Ordinance 2009-10 City employees and Elected Salaries. Ayes Jamie Cain, Darrell Poling, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Motion by Darrell Poling and seconded by Helen Gardner to pass on 1st reading Ordinance 2009-11 and Ordinance 2009-12 Utilities employees and Elected Salaries. Ayes Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning, Darrell Poling and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Council members set the dates of August 12th and August 19th at 6:00 P.M. for budget and salary work sessions. They will meet in the BZA/Plan meeting room.

Motion by Bill Wenning and seconded by Jamie Cain to pass Resolution 2009-17 to establish a budget line item and transfer EDIT money for a City Engineer. Ayes Darrell Poling, Jamie Cain, Bill Wenning and Helen Gardner. Nays none. So passed.

Fire chief Scott Chasteen informed the Council that the State of Indiana KCTCS has built 10 fire fighter survival trailers and the tops fold down. All it would cost the City is the plates, insurance and title. The funds are being paid from District 9 for the building of these trailers. Other fire departments could utilize the use of the trailer but would need to sign a liability form the same as they do for the other trailer the department has. This would be a second survival trailer for the Greensburg fire department and would belong to the City.

Diane Hart-Dawson of the YMCA brought information about a Corporate Wellness Program. A single full membership cost \$29.75 a month, family membership is \$49.75 a month and a joiner's fee is one time only at \$125.

The City is looking into having a Wellness Program for their employees.

Scott Chasteen has been in contact with Jim Stuart and has looked into the comprehensive plan concerning a second fire house for the City.

Mayor Herbert asked the Council to look at some other City's Peddler's Ordinances. He would like to revise the City's Peddler's Ordinance and would rather not allow any door to door sales except for the Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts and some not-for-profit groups.
