

## COMMON COUNCIL MEETING

July 2, 2012

TIME: 7:00 P.M.

Present: Mayor Gary Herbert, Darrell Poling, Terry Wagner, Blake O'Mara, Glenn Tebbe and Jamie Cain

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call was taken.

Minutes from June 4, 2012 were presented for approval. Glenn Tebbe clarified suspending of the rules and for reading passages on the Edgewater Apartment Bond Issuance. Terry Wagner moved to approve the June 4<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes as amended and Darrell Poling seconded all ayes no nays, motion passed.

Mayor Herbert introduced former Mayor Gary Bailey and his summer government class observing how local government works at the meeting this evening.

Glenn Tebbe moved to pass **Ordinance 2012-7 Amending Ordinance 2008-23** on 2<sup>nd</sup> reading and Blake O'Mara seconded. Roll call vote was taken; ayes were Darrell Poling, Terry Wagner, Blake O'Mara and Glenn Tebbe, nays none, motion passed. Jamie Cain moved to suspend the rules for 3<sup>rd</sup> reading and Darrell Poling seconded all ayes no nays, motion passed. Darrell Poling moved to pass Ordinance 2012-7 on 3<sup>rd</sup> reading and Glenn Tebbe seconded all ayes no nays, motion passed.

Glenn Tebbe moved to approve Hitachi Metals abatement renewals and Blake O'Mara seconded all ayes no nays, motion passed.

Darrell Poling moved to approve Valeo abatement renewals and Jamie Cain seconded all ayes no nays, motion passed.

**Gary Murray – City Engineer** requested funding to purchase 100 trees to restore wild life habitat along the Gas Creek corridor \$15,076.43 to purchase 100 trees. Gary Murray requested guidance on where the funding will come from. Street Department will assist in planting the new trees. Jamie Cain moved to approve the purchase of trees from Riverboat Fund and Terry Wagner seconded. Roll call vote was taken; ayes were Darrell Poling, Terry Wagner, Blake O'Mara and Glenn

Tebbe, nays none, motion passed. Darrell Poling asked Gary Murray to clarify the property owner responsibility along the Gas Creek area and Gary Murray indicated that property owners along the creek are responsible for maintaining brush, etc.

**Scott Chasteen – Fire Chief** discussed with Board of Works at their meeting about purchasing a Fire Truck to replace Engine #2. Scott Chasteen has created specifications on a new truck or a demonstrator truck and hopes to start the bidding process within the next month.

**Bridgett Weber – Clerk Treasurer** presented a budget calendar for 2013 budget. Bridgett Weber requested to combine the Building Commission and City Engineer for 2013 and council members agreed to the budget combination. Jamie Cain requested that we have a budget workshop with Council Members and department heads on August 13<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm and set up additional meetings if needed.

Jamie Cain discussed the proclamation for the open burn ban for the City of Greensburg. The proclamation has been posted in 5 public places and fireworks will be postponed at this time. Until future precipitation is received the ban will stay in effect. County Commissioners adopted an ordinance to prohibit open burning during their meeting today.

With nothing further to come before the board, Jamie Cain moved to adjourn and Terry Wagner seconded.
