

COMMON COUNCIL MEETING

August 6, 2012

TIME: 7:00 P.M.

Present: Mayor Gary Herbert, Darrell Poling, Terry Wagner, Blake O'Mara, Glenn Tebbe, absent Jamie Cain

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call was taken.

Minutes from July 2, 2012 were presented for approval. Darrell Poling moved to approve the minutes and Terry Wagner seconded; all ayes no nays, motion passed.

Jeff Smith – Wastewater Superintendent presented Ordinance 2012-12 Amending Ordinance 2010-16 according to state specifications on the definition of Interference. Ordinance 2010-16 was originally defined by federal specifications. Glenn Tebbe stated that he felt the state definitions were clearer in the amended ordinance. Glenn Tebbe moved to pass **Ordinance 2012-12 Amending Ordinance 2010-16** on 1st reading and Blake O'Mara seconded; all ayes no nays, motion passed.

Mark Klosterkemper – Street Commissioner discussed trash collection with commercial residents. One of Mark's concerns is the workmen's compensation with the extra heavy lifting. Mark Klosterkemper has gone back to the original trash ordinance and has been enforcing it. Council members would like to make some adjustments to the current ordinance to enforce times and types of pick up. Council members also want to educate the public of the ordinance and potential changes in a newsletter format.

Mark Klosterkemper – Street Commissioner requested a certification rank for the new hire of a mechanic. Glenn Tebbe moved to pass 2012-13 on first reading and Darrel Polling seconded; all ayes no nays, motion passed. Darrell Poling moved to suspend rules on second reading and Terry Wagner seconded; all ayes no nays, motion passed. Darrell Poling moved to pass Ordinance 2012-13 on second reading Blake O'Mara seconded; all ayes no nays, motion passed. Darrell Poling suspend rules on 3rd reading Blake O'Mara seconded; all ayes no nays, motion passed. Darrell Poling moved to pass Ordinance 2012-13 on its 3rd reading and Blake O'Mara seconded; all ayes no nays, motion passed.

Bridgett Weber – City Clerk-Treasurer presented budget readings Ordinance 2012-9 Water and Wastewater Salary and Wages with \$500.00 increase in salaries, 2012-10 City Employees and Appointed Officers Salary and Wages \$500.00 increase and 2012-11 Elected Officials Salary and Wages and 2012-14 Salary Ordinance for 2013. Darrell Poling moved to pass Ordinance 2012-9, 2012-10, 2012-11, and 2012-14 on its first reading and Blake O'Mara seconded; all ayes no nays; motion passed first reading.

Burn ban will be discussed on Monday August 13th with Emergency Management by conference call.

Darrell Poling presented information from Board of Works Meeting this evening. A bid of \$2510.00 was received from Walter Moore for the dump truck; Melanie Maxwell received permission to close the square for the two days Fall Festival Event; Stacie Chasteen received approval to purchase 4 police cars; Tim Coriden and Chris Stephen amended attorney contract was approved.

Jon Dooley presented a copy of the legal notice for the Airport Improvement Project Public Hearing that was published in July and will be held on August 14th at City Hall.

Tim Coriden reported on the changes in public access laws and Tim Coriden has contacted the public access counselor on such meetings and information requested by the public to be sure that the City of Greensburg is in compliance.

Glenn Tebbe requested an update on the intersection at 421 and I-74. Currently INDOT has no intentions to light this area at this time.

With nothing further to come before the board, Terry Wagner moved to adjourn.
