

COMMON COUNCIL MEETING

OCTOBER 6, 2014

Present: Mayor Gary Herbert, Terry Wagner and Glenn Tebbe, Blake O'Mara, Jamie Cain and Darrell Poling.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call was taken

Terry Wagner moved to approve the September 2 and Special Meeting of September 10, 2014 minutes as presented and Blake O'Mara seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed. Jamie Cain abstained from the September 10th minutes due to being absent.

Gary Murray – City Engineer presented **Ordinance 2014-14** amending Ordinance 2004-1 for **Inspection Costs for second reading**. The increase will cover the cost of the City Inspector paid \$27.50 per inspection. Darrell Poling moved to approve **Ordinance 2014-14 on its second reading** and Jamie Cain seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Mayor Herbert presented the Ordinance 2014-9 City Salaries, 2014-10 Elected Official Salaries, and 2014-11 2015 City Budget 2014-12 Utilities Salaries for second reading. Ordinance 2014-10 was corrected to reflect the revised salary for council members from \$7,000.00 to \$6,700.00 discussed at the budget workshop. Jamie Cain moved to pass **Ordinance 2014-9 City Salaries, 2014-10 Elected Official Salaries as amended, 2014-11 2015 City Budget 2014-12 Utilities Salaries for second reading** and Darrell Poling seconded; roll call vote recorded Blake O'Mara, Terry Wagner, Jamie Cain, Glenn Tebbe and Darrell Poling nays no ayes; motion passed.

Mayor Herbert presented **Ordinance 2014-13** 2015 Greensburg Schools Budget for **second reading**. Glenn Tebbe moved to pass **Ordinance 2014-13** 2015 Greensburg Schools Budget for **second reading** and Darrell Poling seconded; roll call vote recorded Blake O'Mara, Terry Wagner, Jamie Cain, Glenn Tebbe and Darrell Poling nays no ayes; motion passed.

Rick Emsweller was asked to serve on the Decatur County Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee for 2015 and he accepted.

Mayor Herbert presented Dr. Rodney King a plaque for recognition of service to the Board of Works. He is resigning his position to continue his teaching career.

Darrell Poling-provided a report covering speakers and topics at the Board of Works meeting: Wendy Blake was approved for Holiday Walk Parade route and Main Street be used for the 2015 Tenderloin Throwdown; Monfort and Hendricks Streets were approved to be closed for a block party in October; permission was granted to the Clerk-Treasurer's Office to

use professional services to update city personnel policies and procedures; Mark Klosterkemper reported that the Vandalia Road Project will be open for bid letting in Spring 2015 received approval for a supplemental agreement with the consultant to update specifications from Indiana Department of Transportation for this project; Scott Chasteen received approval to sell a fire truck to the Town of Milan.
