

COMMON COUNCIL MEETING

NOVEMBER 3, 2014

TIME: 7:00 PM

Present: Mayor Gary Herbert, Terry Wagner and Glenn Tebbe, Blake O'Mara, Jamie Cain and Darrell Poling.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call was taken

Terry Wagner moved to approve the October 6, 2014 minutes as presented and Blake O'Mara seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Community Action Coalition Board Members Tina Hoeing, Jenny Hanna and Kim Linkel, representing Community Action Coalition (CAC), requested the City of Greensburg act as a fiscal agent for the Drug Free Communities grant that will start in 2015 if funding is approved. Decatur County has acted as fiscal agent for the previous grant cycle and would need to be applied for registered under a new entity. Terry Wagner moved to approve CAC making a grant application using the City of Greensburg as fiscal agent and Darrell Poling seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Gary Murray – City Engineer presented **Ordinance 2014-17 Agricultural Zoning Classification for first reading**. Darrell Poling moved to pass Ordinance 2014-17 on its first reading and Glenn Tebbe seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Gas Creek Flood Plain Maps were also discussed. Blake O'Mara moved to submit revised elevations as a result of the Gas Creek Watershed Improvement Project to Federal Emergency Management Agency to provide the opportunity to obtain flood insurance relief for the residents currently in the flood plan and Terry Wagner seconded; voice vote recorded Blake O'Mara, Glenn Tebbe, Terry Wagner and Darrell Poling ayes Jamie Cain nay; motion passed.

Mayor Herbert presented Ordinance 2014-18 Amending 1998-15 Transient Merchants for first reading. Ordinance is being amended to allow non-profit entities to solicit door to door. Terry Wagner moved to pass 2014-18 for first reading and Jamie Cain seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Marc Coplan – Economic Development Director provided a third quarter report to Council Members.

Darrell Poling-provided a report covering speakers and topics at the Board of Works meeting: Bob King was sworn in as new board of works member; Scott Chasteen was approved to purchase a Fire Truck from Federal Surplus in the amount of \$30,000.00; Parade route for Veteran's Day Parade was

approved; Candidate #2 was nominated by the board to hire as a patrolman; local planning agency agreements were signed for sign replacement and construction inspection for Vandalia Road.

With nothing further to come before the board or the public, Terry Wagner moved to adjourn.
