Funding Requests

Tom Hunter/Greensburg Schools – Requesting \$5,000.00 to provide school safety guidance and police services to Greensburg Community Schools by having an SRO on duty during school hours and for ECA activities.

Bev Karazia/Big Brothers Big Sisters – Requesting \$10,000.00 to provide activities during the summer months, youth and mentors attending different events, and recruiting more mentors for the children that are waiting.

RoJeanna Pank/New Direction- Requesting \$20,000.00 for training, staff, and providing advocacy for the Greensburg Police Department, Decatur County Sheriff's Department, Decatur County Prosecutors Office, and the Decatur County Memorial Hospital.

Nathan Harter & Karen Higginbotham / Greensburg Community Bread of Life- Requesting \$15,000.00 to provide hot meals to those in need, and provide assistance to the homeless, the jobless, the elderly on fixed income, and families in hardship and illness within the community.

Debbie Horton/Lifetime Resources-Catch A Ride- Requesting \$5,000.00 for operational expenses such as fuel, maintenance costs, tire rotations, oil changes, and procedures that help the vehicles run safely and efficiently.
