Motion for approval of minutes from March 7th, 2016 was made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Darren Covington; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays minutes passed.

OLD BUSINESS

Ron May/2nd and final reading of Ord. #2016-2 rezoning south portion of the Hospital

The 2nd reading of Ordinance #2016-2 is to rezone the area so this will become like the remainder of hospital property. Motion for approval was made by Kevin Fleetwood, seconded by Vietta McKenzie; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

NEW BUSINESS

Ron May/ 1st reading of ordinance numbers 2016-3 amending 2013-1, 2016-4, 2016-5, 2016-6, 2016-7, 2016-8

The first reading of Ordinance #2016-3 amending Ordinance #2013-1 Sign Ordinance.

The two recommendations made by the Plan Commission are to have appropriate signage for motor or fuel dispensing facilities. It is recommended by the Plan Commission that motor fuel dispensing canopies, dispensers, and card readers be exempt from being treated as signs. It is also recommended by the Plan Commission that Appendix 1 be added for multiple purposes. Darren Covington moved for approval, Kevin Fleetwood seconded; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

1st reading of Ordinance #2016-4 Rezoning at SR3 & Freeland

This will rezone land at SR3 & Freeland from a light industrial area to a B-2 area. This was recommended by the Plan Commission. Motion for approval was made by Darren Covington, seconded by Darrell Poling; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays, motion passed.

1st reading of Ordinance #2016-5 Rezoning of Board of Health

This will rezone the Board of Health from a R2 to a B2. This was recommended by the Plan Commission. Motion for approval was made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Darren Covington; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays, motion passed.

1st reading of #2016-6 Vacation of a portion of Right-of-Way on Gaston Dr.
This will allow a portion of Gaston Drive to become private. This was recommended by the traffic committee. Motion for approval was made by Darren Covington, seconded by Vietta McKenzie; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

1st reading of Ordinance #2016-7 Parking Restrictions on First Street and Ireland Street
There have been multiple complaints with parking and drivers being able to see around parked vehicles. Motion for approval for parking restrictions was made by Vietta McKenzie, seconded by Darren Covington; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

1st reading of #2016-8 Stop intersection at Moscow Road and Veteran's Way
Do to the number of pedestrians that may use the multi-use path, Moscow Road & Veteran's Way will become an all way stop. This is a recommendation from the Traffic Committee. Motion for approval was made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Darren Covington; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Police Chief Brenda Bridges/Fee changes for requesting copies of records
Chief Bridges came before City Council to request fee changes for copies of records. This money will help with office supplies and the money is put into the LECE fund. This request will be tabled until next month for further discussion. Motion for approval was made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Darren Covington; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Darrell Poling provided the Board of Works summary.

Mayor Dan Mannus announced that heavy trash day will be April 18th – 22nd. He also let the Council and Public know that Hydrants will be flushed on April 12th & 13th, and advised to please keep grass clippings out of drains.

Motion for approval for the meeting to adjourn was made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Vietta McKenzie; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion carried.
