Old Business

Ron May/ 2nd and final reading if Ordinance #2016-16 Vacation of Right of Way

The Council decided that this will be tabled until further information is provided. Motion to table was made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Andre Riley, Umbaugh

Andre Riley from Umbaugh was at the Council meeting for discussion of the 2nd and final reading of Ordinance # 2016-17 Sewage Works Refunding Revenue Bonds, Series 2016. Motion for approval was made by Darren Covington, seconded by Darrell Poling; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

New Business

Steve Garrett/ Introduction of a new Firefighter

Chief Garrett introduced Anthony Bruce as the new Probationary Firefighter.

Marc Coplon/EDC

Marc Coplon with EDC, requested that September 25th, be recognized as Business Appreciation Day. Motion for approval was made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Darren Covington; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed,

Jamie Cain/ CF-1 renewal Res. # 2007-19 RP for Honda

Motion for approval was made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Darrell Poling; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Ron May/ Draft of Title VI

Ron May explained to the Council the draft of the City of Greensburg Title VI Implementation Plan. He requested that the Council let him know of any changes that they would like to see made.

Brendan Bridges/ Change of Rate fee

Brendan discussed the change of rate fees. It was decided that this will be tabled until a later date. The motion to table this discussion was made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Jamie Cain; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Brendan Bridges/ SRO

Brendan Bridges came before the Council to request hiring for an 18th Police Officer as a replacement for the SRO. Motion for approval was made by Darren Covington, seconded by Jamie Cain; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Brendan Bridges/ Take-home vehicles/Request for Transfer

Chief Bridges requested that Police Officers have the ability to take home their vehicles. Chief Bridges requested County wide use for those that do not live in the City limits. The decision was made to table this until the Resolution was final. Chief Bridges also requested that the transfer of funds from fund 339 to the overtime fund. The amount would be \$9,000.00. Chief Bridges explained that this money needed to be moved as a result from a shortage in officers which resulted in overtime. Motion for approval was made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Vietta McKenzie; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Mayor Manus discussed the Old Reservior Project and the new Firestation.

The Council also received information from Ron May on the anticipated cost of the City Park Dam. The anticipated amount at this point is nearly 2 million dollars.

Darrell Poling gave the BOW report.
