***Jamie Cain/ Resolution***

*Deb Lilly/ Resolution*

Deb Lilly requested approval of Resolution #2018-6. Deb explained that this Resolution is supposed to be updated every 10 years in order to apply for a grant for the Southside of the downtown area to make improvements. Motion for approval was made by Vietta McKenzie, seconded by Jamie Cain; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

Deb Lilly advised the Council that a Public Meeting will be held on this topic on May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

*Mary McMarty, SIRPC*

Mary requested approval for the City of Greensburg to serve as the fiscal agent over the Child Advocacy Center. She explained that the City would be responsible for overseeing this in order for the Child Advocacy to receive the grant. Mary stated that after the initial grant, it would be self-sustaining. Motion for approval was made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Darren Covington; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.

*Ron May/ Lincoln St.*

Ron May advised Council that the Lincoln St. project would begin on or after May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Ron said the completion date was set for October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018. This project will complete the rest of Lincoln St. including lighting, curbs, and sidewalks.

*Andrea Dennett/ Lincoln St. Project*

Andrea voiced her concerns that she has a business on Washington and Lincoln and it would be difficult for traffic to turn around on Washington St. After much discussion it was decided that a temporary drive will be put into place and Andrea and the Mayor will have further discussions.


Darrell Poling gave the BOW rundown.

Motion for approval to adjourn was made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood; voice vote recorded all ayes no nays; motion passed.


